Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's)

The Wichita Falls Transit System (WFTS), also known as "Falls Ride", the public transportation system serving the greater portion of the City of Wichita Falls, Texas, hereby announces the establishment of a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 18% for our Section 5339 program as authorized by the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended, for the Federal Fiscal Year, ending September 30, 2022. The proposed goal, rationale and information regarding the DBE Program are available for public review at the address below, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, for 30 days following the date of release of this notice (Dec 19, 2019).
