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## New Public Transportation Facility Groundbreaking

Wichita Falls, Texas—The city of Wichita Falls is excited to invite the public to the official groundbreaking ceremony for the new public transportation administrative and maintenance repair facility. The new 28,000 square foot facility will house the Wichita Falls Transit System, “Falls Ride”, SHARP Lines Rural Transportation, the Wichita Falls Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Chapter 41 DAV offices. In 2018, the city of Wichita Falls was awarded \$9.9 million in grants from the Federal Transit Administration and TxDot to build this facility.

John Burrus, Director of Aviation, Traffic and Transportation said, “This is an exciting first step in the process of building this new facility. The additional space and one centralized location for transportation services will allow us to better serve the public and provide an enhanced customer service experience. We are also pleased that this project is completely financed through grant funding.”

The ceremony will begin at 2 pm with brief remarks from the Mayor and city leaders followed by the groundbreaking.
