Wichita Falls Selected to Host New Event

Wichita Falls, Texas – The Convention and Visitors Bureau is excited to announce that for the first time, Wichita Falls will host the upcoming North Texas Regional Volleyball Tournament, which is sanctioned by USA Volleyball, and presented by Summit Volleyball Club. The tournament will bring over 500 athletes from various cities around Texas and Oklahoma, all to compete at the MPEC. Out of the 49 teams registered, all but 6 are from locations outside of Wichita Falls. Ages participating in the tournament range from 10 to 18.

In addition to the tournament, Summit Volleyball will be hosting a community volleyball clinic Friday, February 28th, from 6 PM to 8 PM at the MPEC. The clinic costs \$30 (cash only) and is open for anyone age 12 to 18 to attend.

All games will be held on Saturday, February 29th, and Sunday, March 1st. Admission is \$10 per day, and children age 10 and under are free. Tickets can be purchased at the gate (cash only).

Andy Cavins, Tournament Organizer, said, “We are excited to be in Wichita Falls for the first time. The cities location allows us to easily attract regional teams to compete. We are looking forward to experiencing Wichita Falls and hopefully continue to bring this tournament back on a regular basis.”
