Temporary Warrant Amnesty

Wichita Falls, Texas – The Wichita Falls Municipal Court understands the potential financial struggles created due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, the Wichita Falls Municipal Court will provide aid to those who have outstanding citations that may soon be in WARRANT.

This is an opportune time to request a reasonable solution, whether it is obtaining an affordable payment plan, an extension on your due date, or other available court options. Many cases have been scheduled to go into warrant for failure to pay or failure to contact the court. These cases have been temporarily placed in a hold for warrant status.

For the next two weeks, starting today, May 20, 2020 and lasting through June 3, 2020, the court is offering an opportunity to save defendants money and possible arrest. If you feel your case may be in warrant, please contact the court for assistance in resolving this matter.

To receive more information regarding your citation, please call 940-761-7880 or visit in person. Please be advised that temporary safety measures may still be in effect, so please allow enough time as cases will be processed as quickly and safely as possible.
