FallsRide Saturday Service Impacts

Wichita Falls, Texas – Due to a shortage in both full-time and part-time bus drivers, the Wichita Falls Public Transportation Division (FallsRide) will have to temporarily stop providing Saturday scheduled bus service. This change will begin next Saturday, December 12, 2020 and last through Saturday, January 30, 2021. The reduction in service will impact all Saturday routes scheduled from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. All other Saturday routes, such as the Night Crawler, will remain in service. The City of Wichita Falls is actively recruiting more drivers and plans to resume normal service on Saturday, February 6, 2021.

Bus service on Saturday, December 5, 2020, will still occur as scheduled. All routes Monday through Friday during this timeframe will still occur as scheduled. To view FallsRide schedules and routes visit: <http://www.wichitafallstx.gov/339/Falls-Ride---Public-Transportation>.
