#### 10 Year Anniversary Adoption Special

Wichita Falls, Texas –The City of Wichita Falls Animal Services Center is celebrating 10 years in our current location. To celebrate our 10 year anniversary, adoption fees have been reduced to \$10. This special rate is available until Saturday, February 13. We encourage you to set up an appointment to come and meet the wonderful animals available for adoption.

- 1 Cat or Kitten: \$10.00
- 1 Dog or Puppy: \$10.00

This reduced adoption fee also covers the following for each animal adopted:

- Vaccinations,
- Worming,
- Feline Leukemia testing for cats,
- Heartworm testing for dog 6 months and older,
- Flea and tick preventative, and
- Microchipping.

In addition to the fee, adopters must pre-pay for the animal to be spayed and neutered at their veterinarian of choice. Adopted adult animals will be taken to the chosen veterinarian's office by Animal Services staff. Puppies and kittens will be given a date that the procedure must be completed by.
