Wichita Falls, Texas – The City of Wichita Falls is excited to announce a new program called the Wichita Falls Citizens Academy. The Academy is designed to provide the residents of Wichita Falls an inside look at our local City government. Residents will have the opportunity to learn the basic roles and functions of municipal government through in person classes, tours and activities. Various topics will be covered, including City Council roles and responsibilities, general City services such as police, fire and public works, community development and planning and many other Wichita Falls-focused municipal topics. The Wichita Falls Citizens Academy is a great way to develop relationships with City staff while learning more about their responsibilities, and finding ways to become more involved.

Classes will be held on Tuesdays, from 6pm to 8pm, beginning May 11, 2021. The format will be a mixture of class and activity setting. The minimum age for enrollment is 18 years of age. The Academy will conclude at the City Council meeting on Tuesday, July 6, 2021 with a brief graduation presentation.
