#### **Wichita Falls – Wichita County Public Health District Appointment Based Vaccine Clinic**

Wichita Falls, Texas - The Wichita Falls-Wichita County Public Health District has received 585 doses of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. The Texas Department of State Health Services has notified vaccine providers that they should begin to administer the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to adolescents from 12 to 17 years old, in line with federal guidance. This notice comes after the Food and Drug Administration approved an emergency use authorized of the Pfizer vaccine for adolescents on May 10, 2021. The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices also recommended it for that age group.

The Wichita Falls-Wichita County Public Health District will have a Pfizer COVID-19 Appointment Based Vaccine Clinic on Thursday, June 10, from 9am to 1pm at the Health District. This clinic is offered to anyone ages 12 and older. Minors must be accompanied by a guardian.
