Wichita Falls City Winter Weather Update

Wichita Falls, Texas – City offices in Wichita Falls will be closing at noon due to forecasted unsafe travel conditions.

All non-emergency City offices will be closed.

The Streets Department continues preparation of trucks to get streets in the city cleared when snow falls. If you do not need to travel stay off the roads.

The Utility Collections office (Water Department) will close at noon today. If you would like to make a payment please visit www.wichitafallstx.gov, or call 877-281-0607. No new accounts or closing of accounts will occur until the offices resume normal services.

The Water Distribution Department is only taking Emergency Shutoff requests at this time. The number to call if you need an emergency shut off is (940)761-4333.

All American Eagle flights in and out of Wichita Falls Regional Airport for Wednesday (2/2/2022) and Thursday (2/3/2022) have been cancelled. At this time terminal operations at both the Regional Airport 4:00am-1:00am and Kickapoo Airport 6:00am to 8:00pm will remain open during normal operating hours. Terminal operations are subject to change.

The Transfer Station and Landfill will close at noon Wednesday. The Sanitation Department is also planning a delayed start for trash and waste collections and opening the landfill and transfer station until 10 am on Thursday. This is subject to change as the storm develops.

The Municipal Court has cancelled its Thursday trial. Potential Jurors do not need to report. Should the Court be close on Thursday or Friday, no added penalties will be assessed for late appearance date. All appearance dates will be extended.
