Wichita Falls, Texas – The City of Wichita Falls received grant funding from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) which totaled approximately \$29 million. The City and City Councilors are asking for input from its citizens on what they believe the ARPA grant funding should be spent on!
